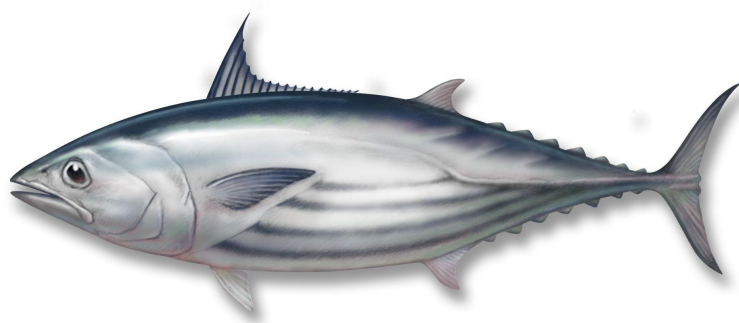

Hy-Vee Tuna Vessel Name List November 2024 - November 2025

Report Date: June 2026



Introduction

Now in its fifth consecutive year, Hy-Vee Inc. and its wholly-owned distribution subsidiary, Perishable Distributors of Iowa (PDI), have produced a public list of the tuna vessels used to procure raw material for its private-label shelf-stable tuna assortment as part of the company's commitment to improving seafood transparency.

Collecting vessel data from tuna suppliers and maintaining a public vessel list improves supply chain transparency for Hy-Vee stakeholders and supports proactive efforts to identify potential risks related to illegal fishing and social concerns. Importantly, Hy-Vee remains the only U.S. retailer to publicly undertake this activity, demonstrating its commitment to sustainability and transparency.

FishWise has been a key sustainability partner to Hy-Vee since 2011, helping establish and guide the business's nationally recognized [Responsible Choice Seafood](#) program. In 2025, FishWise engaged with Hy-Vee private-label tuna suppliers to collect and verify the names of the tuna vessels supplying raw material for the private-label assortment during a 12-month purchase period.

In collaboration with Global Fishing Watch, FishWise used its proprietary Vessel Risk Dashboard tool to assess risks of illegal, unreported, and unregulated (IUU) fishing, as well as human and labor rights risks within Hy-Vee's private-label shelf-stable tuna supply chains. The assessment helps Hy-Vee understand whether any mitigation efforts are needed within its supply chains.

Key Findings

FishWise cross-referenced each unique fishing vessel name with the [ISSF Proactive Vessel Register](#), [Regional Fisheries Management Organizations \(RFMO\) vessel lists](#), [IUU Vessel List](#), FishWise Labor Allegations List (*non-public resource*), and the [Global Fishing Watch](#) (GFW) database.

From the vessel name verification process, FishWise identified 8 pole and line vessels, 9 purse seine vessels, and one unknown gear type vessel that supplied raw material for Hy-Vee's private-label shelf-stable tuna assortments from November 2024 to November 2025.

Although public disclosure of supply chain information has become commonplace in other industries, the seafood sector has struggled to achieve greater transparency due to limited data availability and verification capabilities. As pioneers in this level of supply chain transparency, Hy-Vee and FishWise are optimistic that other U.S. retailers will undertake similar efforts to drive broader industry accountability across their seafood supply chains.

Action Plan

Based on the outcomes of this activity, Hy-Vee will prioritize three key actions over the next 12 months:

1. **Continue the tuna fishing vessel transparency activity** in 2026-2027 as part of Hy-Vee's seafood supply chain due diligence plan.
2. **Evaluate the results of the Vessel Risk Dashboard analysis** and proactively engage with suppliers to discuss findings.
3. **Address any identified non-compliance issues** using Hy-Vee's internal Tuna Vessel Remediation Plan and Implementation Guide.

Appendix 1: Tuna Fishing Vessel Name List

The fishing vessels identified below supplied raw materials to Hy-Vee's private-label tuna assortments from November 2024 to November 2025. Fishing vessel name data has been anonymized and aggregated to protect supplier confidentiality. Individual fishing vessels may change from year to year due to the dynamic nature of seafood sourcing and supply chain conditions.
